

Companion Travel Allocation

When more than one official travel together in the same vehicle to a basketball event, those officials will share in the travel pay. The following provides an explanation on how to allocate the travel pay.

Each official in the vehicle and the vehicle receive a point. The points are summed and the sum is used to allocate the travel pay. The total travel pay is divided by the numbers of points with each official and the vehicle being allocated a portion of the travel pay.

For example, two officials travel together to call a game and the travel pay is \$36. Each official and the vehicle receive a point, 3 points. The travel pay is divided by three (3). The vehicle is allocated \$12 and each official is allocated \$12. Therefore, the driving official would receive \$24 and the passenger official would receive \$12.

For an additional example, the same scenario applies except three (3) officials travel together in the same vehicle. The travel pay would be divided by four (4). The vehicle is allocated \$9 and each official is allocated \$9. Therefore, the driving official would receive \$18 and each of the passenger officials would receive \$9.
